Adults of a certain age—don your tie-died best. **It'll be groovy, man.**



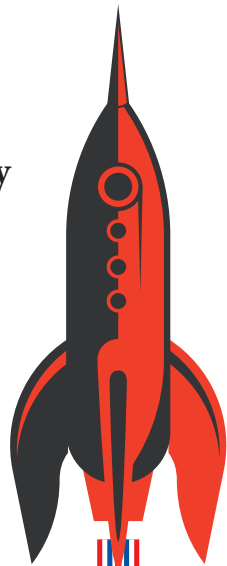
Add retro rockets to your bicycle and zoom into view during the July 4th Parade.
